Question: Is there a fee associated with the permit from the fire code official as outlined in section 307?

Answer: No, there is no fee associated with the permit.

Question: How long is the permit obtained from the fire code official good for?

Answer: The permit is valid from April 1 through March 31 or when there is a change of rentership/ownership.

Question: Does a 1 or 2 family dwelling need a permit to have a recreational fire?

Answer: No, a permit is only required for a dwelling with 3 or more dwelling units.

Question: How long will it take me to obtain a permit?

Answer: Less than 14 days

Question: How far away from combustibles/structures does my approved fire container have to be?

Answer: 15 feet
